THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:

WHEREAS Canadian Arsenals Limited, a Company wholly owned or controlled by the Canadian Government, is operating on behalf of the Government arsenals and plants, and in the course of such operation has in its custody certain machinery and equipment, the property of His Majesty; the Company is also producing certain military and other stores for His Majesty;

AND WHEREAS Section 432 of the Criminal Code provides in part as follows:

"The Governor in Council may also prescribe, by notice published in the Canada Gazette, what additional or other marks are appropriated for His Majesty's use in or on naval, military, militia or other stores and property, whether such stores or property belong to His Majesty in the right of His Government of Canada, or in the right of any other of His Majesty's Dominions."

AND WHEREAS it is considered advisable that a distinctive mark be appropriated for His Majesty's use in or on stores and property in the custody of or produced by Canadian Arsenals Limited;

THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Reconstruction and Supply, and pursuant to provisions of Section 432 of the Criminal Code, is pleased to appropriate and doth hereby appropriate the mark shown on the Schedule hereto for His Majesty's use in or on stores or property in the custody of or produced by Canadian Arsenals Limited.
